




- 1. Remove AvSax<sup>®</sup> from vacuum packing by pulling on the red strip.
- 2. Open the AvSax<sup>®</sup> by pulling the yellow tab upwards on the front flap of the AvSax<sup>®</sup>.
- 3. Lay AvSax<sup>®</sup> on a flat surface with the opening slightly raised and add a minimum of 1 litre of water, distributing it as evenly as possible to wet the lower inner sides.
- 4. Turn AvSax<sup>®</sup> over and repeat step 3.
- 5. Insert the overheating device and close the flap with battery down if possible.
- 6. Move AvSax<sup>®</sup> to an appropriate location.
- 7. Open a corner of AvSax<sup>®</sup> and add up to 13 litres of additional water as required to mitigate the effects of the device.

(Do not add more water if device has been put in AvSax<sup>®</sup> only as a precaution)

8. Reclose flap and monitor AvSax<sup>®</sup> for the duration of the flight.



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
